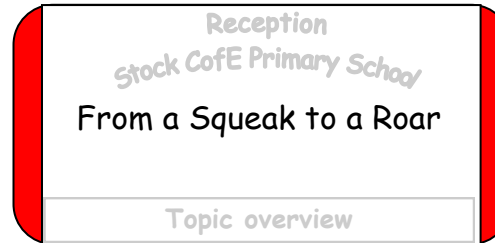

Maps and directions—zoo layout

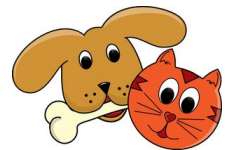
