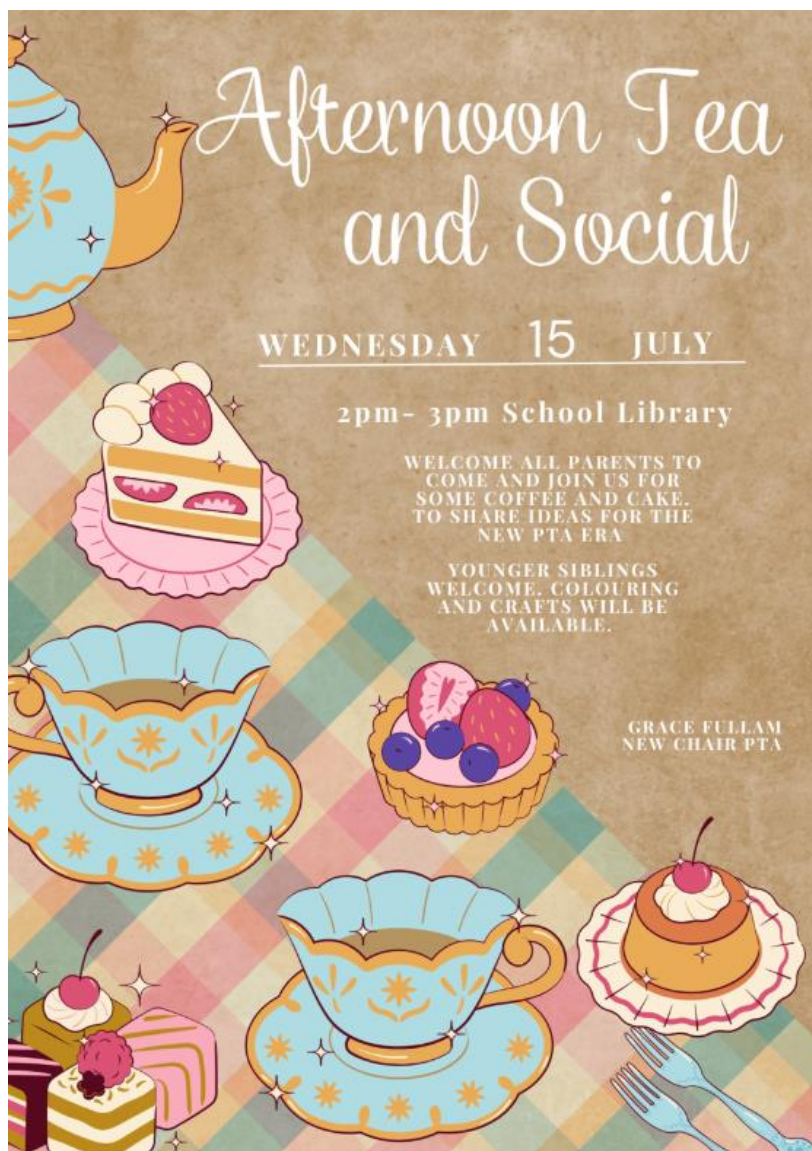
## PTA – Tea and Chat – 15<sup>th</sup> July

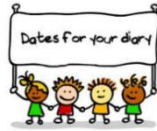
