Year 6 Leavers Service

Prior to the service the children completed a range of activities which centred on the theme of growth. The children were able to reflect on how they had grown in primary school and how they would continue to grow as they moved on to secondary school and beyond. It was a great opportunity for children to see how Stock Primary School is part of a larger community of schools by being a Church of England school.



Year 1 School Trip to Danbury Country Park

Year 1 enjoyed a fun trip to Danbury Country Park, where they explored the natural world through a variety of hands-on activities. The children had a great time pond dipping and discovering creatures— they were very excited to find a tadpole! They also went insect hunting, carefully searching for minibeasts in their habitats and observing them. In the afternoon, the children worked together and used sticks and natural materials to build animal dens. To finish the day, they created butterflies using leaves they found for leaf printing on fabric. 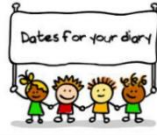
